Sermon Schedule **August**

August 1

AM – Beginning With That Scripture (Acts 8:26-35)

As we conclude our summer series from Isaiah, we will look at passages that point to the Messiah and see what we can learn about Jesus from the scroll of Isaiah.

PM – Revealed, Protected, Sanctified (John 17:6-19)

As Jesus continues this lengthy prayer, he turns from praying about himself to praying for the apostles. Tonight we will consider three things I see in this section that Jesus brings out in his prayer.

August 8

AM – Growing Up Spiritually (Eph. 4:11-16)

I heard a statement that struck me. A person asked, "How many years can we sit in the pew and not look more like Jesus?" Our elders desire for this congregation to reach a level of spiritual maturity that calls us to be wholly devoted to God. For the next four weeks we want to take a look at a Biblical plan for spiritual maturity.

PM – Jesus Prayed For You (John 17:20-26)

In this last section of Jesus' passionate prayer of John 17, we read about Jesus praying for us, the people who believe what the apostles have taught. Consider the desire for unity Jesus closes with in this prayer.

August 15

AM – Lambs Among Wolves (Luke 10:1-3)

To reach a desire of devotion to God, we as a church must consider our part in proclaiming God among the people. There are many ways in which a person can proclaim the good news of Jesus Christ. Let us consider some collective and some individual ways of proclamation and service.

PM – The First Sip (John 18:1-11)

John does not record the garden prayer that he was a part of. He simply begins the section with the arrest of Jesus and His words that He must “drink the cup the Father has given me.”

August 29

AM – A New Me (Col. 3:5-14)

In the church we use terms like “transformation.” As we continue this study of becoming wholly devoted to God, we need to see how we have been and can be transformed into the image of Jesus Christ. In this body we offer several avenues to help in transformation.

PM – Death and Denial (John 18:15-27)

Jesus now appears before a Jewish court whose only desire is to see him dead. Outside, Peter strives not to die and, in seeking to save his own life, denies Jesus three times.
